WHAT IS AN MSF?

MSFs make it possible for you to communicate with your students about the effectiveness of a course before the end of the term. Many instructors find that the feedback process allows them to clarify their course learning goals and expectations for students. The feedback often leads to simple changes that can help motivate students and enhance learning. Students appreciate being asked about their views on issues most critical to their success.

There are several options for gathering midterm student feedback. A CRLT consultant will work with you to design a process that best meets your needs. In all cases, the process is confidential; CRLT consultants only share student feedback with the instructor.
